1. Ensures tools and equipment are in top condition.			
2. Always wears proper personal protective equipment.			
3. Follows safety procedures recommended for each power tool.			
4. Removes jewelry, eliminates loose clothing, and confines long hair.			
5. Wears a sturdy pair of safety shoes when working with heavy pieces of wood such as sheets of plywood and two by four studs.			
6. Keeps materials neatly stacked.			
7. Keeps work area clean and free from small scraps, excessive sawdust and oil.			
8. Always removes nails from lumber.			
9. Keeps tables of machines and other work surfaces free of nails, tools, wrenches and materials.			
10. Never tries to move materials by a person who is using a power tool or machine.			
11. Never attempts to speak to or otherwise startle a person using a power tool or machine.			
12. Never starts or stops a machine for someone else.			
13. Always follows the machine operator's instructions when helping.			
14. Always carries sharp or pointed tools away from the body. Never puts them in pockets.			
15. Never holds a small piece of wood in fingers as it is being cut.			
16. Always uses the guards on machines, and if guards are not available, uses holding and clamping devices and push sticks.			
17. Plans work before beginning. Gets help before beginning instead of after getting into difficulty.			
18. Never works on machines or power tools if tired or hurried.			
19. Makes sure that machine has come to a full stop before adjusting or oiling it, or changing a blade.			
20. Gets first aid treatment for even the slightest scratch.			
21. Wears a dust respirator when sanding.			
22. Knows the location of the fire extinguishers and the proper use of same for each of the Classes of Fires.			
23. Returns all finishing materials to metal containers and cabinets.			
24. Places all oily rags in an approved metal container.			
25. Uses the dust collection system for stationary tools.			
26. Keeps fingers and hands out of the path of sharp edged cutting tools.
